The Tosa East Girls cross country team had a big day with a number of PR's, remarkable performances, and movement on the top 50 list at the Manitowoc Len Nikolai Invite. The girls were rolling on Saturday and the weather finally decided to cooperate. The 3rd ranked Red Raiders took the victory with 53 points, over 2nd place and 9th ranked Kaukauna (56 pts) and 3rd place and 6th ranked Brookfield East (103 pts). This was the first varsity win at the meet since 2016 and second win in a row this year. Senior Nadia Phillips notched her own victory winning the individual title in a dazzling PR time of 18:03, which is currently ranked 3rd in Wisconsin for Division 1. Fellow senior Chiara
