Longfellow-Reading Emphasis. 1 Class period 2 or 3 days a week. Reading Plus. Citizenship-RFL WI Forward
Whitman-Academic Resource. 1 class period 2 or 3 days a week. Focus on reteaching/organization intended to improve access to general ed classes and IEP goals. No specific curriculum, Responsibility for learning grade. WI Forward. Reading Plus, Lexia
