On this day February 23, 1868 William Edward Burghardt Du Bois was born in Great Barrington, Massachusetts. Dub Bois was a sociologist, historian, educator, and sociopolitical activist who argued for immediate racial equality of African-Americans. As a result of the racism he experienced while attending Fisk University he decided to dedicate his life to ending racism and uplifting African-Americans.
