Wauwatosa East High School Ranked by U.S. News as Best High School

Wauwatosa East High School was recently ranked as a top high school in both the state and nation and named a silver medal school. In the 2016 U.S. News Best High Schools rankings, 64 Wisconsin schools earned silver medals and 95 were awarded bronze. The state also has five gold medal schools.

To produce the 2016 Best High Schools rankings, U.S. News & World Report teamed with North Carolina-based RTI International, a global nonprofit social science research firm. RTI implemented the U.S. News comprehensive rankings methodology, which is based on these key principles: that a great high school must serve all of its students well, not just those who are college bound, and that it must be able to produce measurable academic outcomes to show it is successfully educating its student body across a range of performance indicators.

After narrowing down the number of applicable public high schools in all 50 states and the District of Columbia from 28,561 to 19,908, Wauwatosa East High School was ranked 23rd in the state and 1,065th in the nation.
